Facts at a glance:

- The earliest point at which an application can be made for a Registrar position is during Postgraduate Year 2 (PGY2) with entry for successful trainees in Postgraduate Year 3 (PGY3). It is encouraged at House Officer level to complete a broad range of runs before making an application.
- In the 2015-2016 training year, 17 new Registrars were selected throughout NZ with 7 positions for first year Registrars in the Auckland Region.
- There are approximately 45 Radiology Registrar positions overall in the Auckland Region.
- There are approximately 296 Radiology Consultants (Diagnostic and Interventional) in NZ.

Training Programme Format:

- The five year training programme involves trainees rotating through-out the three District Health Boards in Auckland every 2 months.
- Examinations for Part I are taken in approximately October of the first year. The Part II examination is in two parts, Pathology and Radiodiagnosis which are taken simultaneously in the fourth year.
