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I refer to your Official Information Request dated 2 November 2020 to the MoH and transferred from the MoH to Auckland DHB on 13 November 2020 requesting the following information:

I would like to request the amount paid for intraocular lenses, the type of intraocular lenses purchased and the volume ordered per year for the last five years.

Types of intraocular lenses used

Monofocal IOL: SA60AT, SN60AT, MA60AC, MA60MA

Toric IOL: Alcon SN6AT with number suffix eg. T1, T2, T3, etc.- used for Astigmatic pts.

Iris Clip IOL- Artisan lenses

Scleral IOL- Alcon Cz70BD, Zeiss EC-3 Pal lens

ACIOL- Alcon MTA4UO

Toric IOL- Rayner T-flex 623T

Rayner Sulcoflex Toric

Sensar AMO

Artificial Iris Fiber- used for aniridia pts. mostly combined with Cataract surgery. Glaukos I-stent- usually inserted during a Cataract surgery by Glaucoma Surgeons. Morchers- used with a lens implant for support of the capsule in a complicated Cataract. CTR's 14, 14A, 14C, 67B, 67G, 67F, 68, 96C, 96G, 50D, 6E, 96F

The volume of intraocular lenses ordered per year for five years is very difficult and time consuming to extract through our system due to the number of different lens types and then the further split by dioptre. Therefore, we are declining to answer this section of your request under section 18(f) of the Official Information Act as obtaining the data would require substantial

collation and research. We have provided the total cataract procedures per year which will give you an assumption of the number of lenses ordered.

I would like to request the amount paid for viscoelastics, surgical blades and sutures for cataract surgery."

Surgical blades and sutures are used across the theatre suite for different specialties and are not able to be specifically attributed to cataract surgery, so we are unable to give you the total amount paid for these products for cataract surgery.
