

Re Official Information Request – Workforce statistics

I refer to your official information request dated 16 July 2020 requesting the following information:

I am looking for the number of early-career nurses (nurses in the first five years of practice) employed at Auckland City Hospital. I would also be interested in any information that can be provided about this group such as ages, ethnicity, etc.

- As at 30 June 2020, 818 positions at Auckland DHB are filled by early-career nurses
 - o These nurses' first year of qualification was in 2015 or after.
 - O There are 4,214 nursing positions. 3,103 positions are filled by nurses with a first year of qualification before 2015, and 293 positions are filled by nurses whose year of qualification is not known.
 - O Excludes contractors and employees on parental leave or long term leave without pay.
- The average age of early-career nurses is 27.4 years.
