Re: Official Information Act request Bed availability and maternity admissions

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 25 January 2021 requesting the following information:

Can you please provide the following information under the Official Information Act:

- 1. Can you tell me the overall number of beds available and the number occupied each day last week (Monday 11 January to Sunday 17 January).
- 2. What is the average daily number of maternity inpatient admissions, between 1 December 2020 and January 2021 to date and how does this compare to this time last year?

The tables below provide a summary of occupied inpatient beds at midnight and resourced beds at midnight. The number of resourced beds is adjusted depending on patient demand and staff availability. The number of people cared for in hospital during a day is usually greater than midnight occupancy due to people being discharged home on the same day they arrive (for example for planned daycase procedures).

Emergency department trolleys, operating rooms and day procedure beds have not been included in the count below.
