A breakdown by DHB showing how many nurses had completed the online ICU training module for nurses by August 17, and also now (most up to date figures available).

Response

The NZ Critical Care Pandemic Relief Team Resource Ko Awatea training package was released for Auckland DHB staff Thursday 26 August. No nurses had enrolled and none had completed as of 17 August.

As of 28 September, there were 17 Auckland DHB nurses enrolled and nine had completed.
