## If you haven't had your first COVID-19 vaccine dose yet, come and see us now!

Bring your ID card to the vaccination centre and we'll fit you in or make an appointment for a time that suits.

- When you click on the link to book an appointment you will be asked to change your password.
- You'll be allocated the first time available. If the time doesn't work, you can change it. For help see the helpful guide on Hippo or visit the **Employee Support Centre.**

- If you're getting vaccinated during work hours check with your charge nurse or manager to make sure the time works for your service.

  - O Weekends, 8.30am 4pm
